


Study Groups Begin Next Week

Book Study of Bonhoeffer's *Discipleship* to Meet In-Person and Online

Who: Fr. Josh and E.R. Haire will co-lead a study of Dietrich Bonhoeffer's *Discipleship*. All are invited to participate.

Info: Bonhoeffer lived in trying times. He was a German theologian and pastor who argued for the church in Germany to resist National Socialism and Hitler's power during the 1930s and 1940s. His book *Discipleship* begins with the lines, "Cheap grace is the mortal enemy of our church. Our struggle today is for costly grace." Join in discussions on what following Jesus requires of us. Ultimately, Bonhoeffer was arrested and executed in a concentration camp less than a week before the camp was liberated.
